

## Location WV11

This is apparently a small exposure, a few metres across, just above the path that is south and parallel to the main track that you followed on day 1 to visit locations 2 and 3. However, you may recall from the first site that you visited on day 1, that on the west side of the hill much of the ground is covered in loose material that has moved down-slope by solifluction. Hence there are loose blocks of rock in this area that may at times appear to be *in situ* but are not. What do you think about the rock here? Remember, even if a block like this is not *in situ* it can still be a useful clue if you are mapping, IF you remember that blocks only slide downhill from their source, not uphill!
