

Location WV19

This is a cliff that runs around the hill from near the wooden 'staircase' that crosses a wall east of Location 6, extending almost to Location 22b.

The cliff here is best examined by following a path that branches off the path from King Arthur's Cave, climbing up through the woods, just after the sharp elbow bend, before it reaches the wooden staircase. This path eventually meets the track down from the 22a/22b area. From the path the cliff base can be accessed by a short (not too steep) scramble up the slope through the trees. The cliff is far more visible in the autumn - winter.

Parts of these rocks may react slowly with dilute HCl.
