**Retaining wall, north-east of Shelsley Beauchamp**



On the N side of the lane is located a spring and water from this forms a pond. There is a retaining wall (slabs of reddish sandstone) built just above the spring position to stabilise the bank. This at first appears as a natural exposure, and you may think that it could be the local red rock from which the 'head' we saw earlier was derived. It is in fact a man-made feature, possibly using imported stone. What features might give you a clue that this is the case?

The pond is private property so keep to the footpath.
